

WAYS TO DISINFECT YOUR HOUSE

HARD (NON- POROUS) SURFACES

1

Clean dirty surfaces with soap and water. Prepare a bleach solution of 4 teaspoons bleach per quart of water or 1/3 cup bleach per gallon of water. Apply to surface, let sit one minute, rinse and dry surface.

SOFT (POROUS) SURFACES

2

Remove visible dirt or other material. Wash items as appropriate or use an EPA-approved disinfectant for porous surfaces.

ELECTRONICS

3

Remove any visible contamination. Follow manufacturer's guidance for cleaning if available; if no such guidance is available, consider use of 70% alcohol swabs or sprays followed by thorough drying.

LINENS AND OTHER LAUNDRY

4

Use the warmest water setting appropriate for the items and dry completely.

HAND HYGIENE

5

Frequently wash hands with warm water and soap for at least 20 seconds. If hands are not visibly dirty, hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol may be used.
